



Kitten Vaccination Schedule

- **10 days**- Start deworming with Strongid-T. Repeat every 2 weeks.
- **4 weeks**- Start kitten food - Start weaning kittens as they increase food intake.

Leukemia/FIV test: Can be done any time after 6 weeks of age. This test is highly recommended before vaccinating.

 - FVRCP – Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia, Chlamydia Psittaci
- **Deworming**

- **12 weeks**

- **Core Vaccinations**
 - FVRCP – Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia, Chlamydia Psittaci
 - Rabies
- **Lifestyle Vaccinations**
 - FeLV – Leukemia – If pet goes outside or encounters any cats that go outside.
- **Deworming**

- **16 weeks**

- **Core Vaccinations**
 - FVRCP – Feline Rhinotracheitis, Calici, Panleukopenia, Chlamydia Psittaci
- **Lifestyle Vaccinations**
 - FeLV – Leukemia – If pet goes outside or encounters any cats that go outside.
- **Deworming**

- **Heartworm Prevention** - Start before 6 months old.
- **Flea/Tick Prevention** – Start after 8 weeks old. (Call for options if younger than 8 weeks)
- Microchipping can be performed at any age
- Spaying and neutering can be performed any time after 3 months of age.
