

Puppy Vaccination Schedule

- **10 days**- Start deworming. Repeat every 2 weeks.
 - **4 weeks**- Start puppy food - Start weaning puppies as they increase food intake.
 - **6 weeks**- DAP–Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, and Parvovirus (not counted as part of the puppy series)

- **8 weeks**
 - **Core Vaccinations**
 - DAP – Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, and Parvovirus
 - **Monthly Heartworm/Deworming and Flea/Tick/Mite Prevention**
 - **12 weeks**
 - **Core Vaccinations**
 - DAP - Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, and Parvovirus
 - Rabies
 - **Lifestyle Vaccinations**
 - Bordetella – If pet encounters other dogs, boarding, grooming, etc.
 - Influenza (H3N8, H3N2) - If pet encounters other dogs, boarding, grooming, etc.
 - Leptospirosis spp. – For hunting and outdoor pets possibly exposed to raccoon, skunk, opossum or rat urine and public bodies of water.
 - **Monthly Heartworm/Deworming and Flea/Tick/Mite Prevention**
 - **16 weeks**
 - **Core Vaccinations**
 - DAP - Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, and Parvovirus
 - **Lifestyle Vaccinations**
 - Bordetella – If pet encounters other dogs, boarding, grooming, etc.
 - Influenza (H3N8, H3N2) - If pet encounters other dogs, boarding, grooming, etc.
 - Rattlesnake – If pet may encounter a snake.
 - Leptospirosis spp. – For hunting and outdoor pets possibly exposed to raccoon, skunk, opossum or rat urine and public bodies of water.
 - **Monthly Heartworm/Deworming and Flea/Tick/Mite Prevention**
 - Start lifelong prevention.
 - **20 weeks**
 - **Core Vaccinations - Given to High-Risk Puppies**
 - DAP - Distemper, Adenovirus Type 2, and Parvovirus
 - **Lifestyle Vaccinations**
 - Rattlesnake – If pet may encounter a snake.
 - **Monthly Heartworm/Deworming and Flea/Tick/Mite Prevention**
 - Start lifelong prevention. (if not started at 16 weeks)
-
- Initial Wellness Exam – Schedule as soon as possible.
 - Heartworm Prevention - Start before 6 months old.
 - Flea/Tick Prevention – Start after 8 weeks old. (Call for options if younger than 8 weeks)
 - Microchipping can be performed at any age.
 - Spaying and neutering can be performed any time after 3 months of age.
